

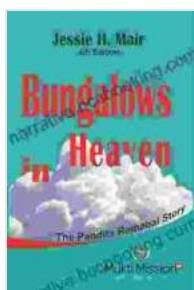
Bungalows In Heaven: The Story of Pandita Ramabai

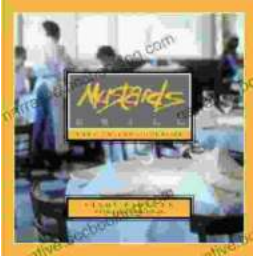

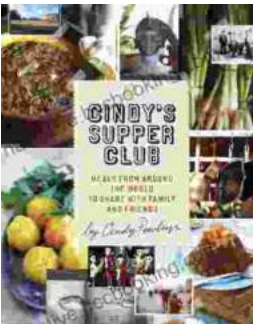
