## Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in two colors (one for the bib and one for the reindeer applique)

- Crochet hook size H/8 (5mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

### **Stitches Used**

- Single crochet (sc)
- Half double crochet (hdc)
- Double crochet (dc)
- Slip stitch (sl st)

### **Pattern**

#### **Bib:**

1. Chain 50.
2. Sc in the second chain from the hook and in each chain across. (49 sc)
3. Ch 1, turn.
4. Sc in each sc across. (49 sc)
5. Repeat rows 3-4 until the bib measures the desired length.
6. Sl st to join the last row to the first row.

#### **Reindeer Applique:**

1. Ch 6, join with a sl st to form a ring.

2. Ch 1, sc in the ring, hdc in the ring, dc in the ring, hdc in the ring, sc in the ring. (5 sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc)
3. Sl st to join the last sc to the first sc.
4. Ch 1, sc around the ring. (10 sc)
5. Sl st to join the last sc to the first sc.
6. Ch 1, sc in each sc around. (10 sc)
7. Sl st to join the last sc to the first sc.
8. Ch 1, sc in each sc around, increasing 2 sc in each corner. (14 sc)
9. Sl st to join the last sc to the first sc.
10. Ch 1, sc in each sc around, increasing 2 sc in each corner. (18 sc)
11. Sl st to join the last sc to the first sc.
12. Ch 1, sc in each sc around. (18 sc)
13. Sl st to join the last sc to the first sc.
14. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

### **Assembly:**

1. Sew the reindeer applique to the bib.
2. Weave in any loose ends.

Your adorable crochet huggy bib with reindeer applique is now complete! This festive accessory is sure to keep your little one looking stylish and clean all season long.

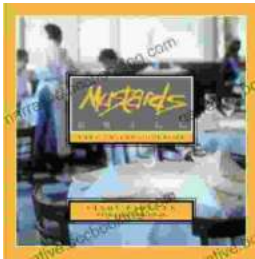
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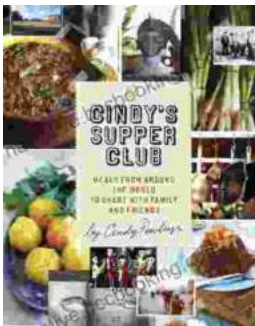
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
